# CONSTITUTION AND BY LAWS BLACK FACULTY AND STAFF ORGANIZATION CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY

#### Article I. NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Black Faculty and Staff Organization elacter State University, hereinafter referred to atthe BFSO of CSU.

#### Article II. PREAMBLE

Article III . PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

Section A Purpose

The BFSO of CSU shall exist for the following purposes:

1. To represent the intest of black faculty and staff;SU shall III 1 inte

- 5. To provide the University community with a black perspective for institutional and programmatic development to enhance inclusiveness.
- 6. To serve as resource bureau of concerned black people for, the black community, and the general populace of Northeast Ohio;
- 7. To provideboth leadership and other supportive servicesheradministrative and academic levels to facilitate delivery of efficient and effective service to all elements of the University.

#### Article IV. MEMBERSHIP OF THE ORGANIZATION

#### Section A Membership

The membership of the BFS@f CSUis opento all full-time and partime employees (faculty and contract and classified staff) who are financially in good standing whosupport the purpose and objectives the organization. All such persons are eligibler membership irrespective of the sitionheld at the University.

### Section B Type of Membership

There shall be one type of membership; active members in financial good standing shall be entitled to one YRWHLQWKHRUJDQL]DWLRneefings Fof Xthe brogardization and Mhould-bothice in EtheVLQHVV organization.

#### Article V. OFFICERS OF THE ORGANIZATION

#### Section A Officers

The officers of the BFS@f CSUshall be President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurena Parliamentarian. The President Vice President shall be either faculty or staff members, respectively. If the president is a member of sta\( \)fidee President shall be a faculty member of vice versa.

- 1. All officers of the organization shall be tend upon by the active membership present at the electoral meeting.
- 2. The officers of the organization shall be elected by a majority vote of all votes cast by members in good standing.
- 3. Term of office shall be for two years. Officers may serve a maximum coconsecutive terms in the same office. In the event of a vacancy, the President shall appoint with three positive committee a replacement serve the remainder of the term.

#### Section B:Duties of Officers

- 1. THE PRESIDENT: The Presidental preside at all meetings of the organization and shall be chairperson and preside at meetings of the Executive Committee. The President shall perform the duties as necessary to assure progress of the organization, especially:
  - a. To execute policy set by the organization and assume ultimate responsibility for executing decisions of the Executive Committee members or members present at a regular or call meeting
  - b. To serve as spokesperson of the organization;
  - c. To appoint members of all standing and members committees;

d. To delegate responsibilities to each standing committee.

The President shall be an ex officio member of all committees.

- 3. THE RECORDING SECRETARY: The Recording Secretary shall be responsible for maigntaini accurate records and minutes of all general membership meetings and Executive Committee Meetings. The Recording Secretary, in conjunction with the President, shall prepare agendas for all general membership and Executive Committee meetraged.personshall perform in the absence of the Corresponding Secretary.
- 4. THE CORRESPONDING SECRETARY: The **Ce**sponding Secretary shall communicate ting notices to all members before organization calls or schedules medtlegs she shall coordinate telephonecalls to members to give or obtain information for the President or the Executive Committee. He or she shall affix the seal and execute official legal documents of the organization. Said person shall perform in the absence of the Recording Secretary.
- 5. THE TREASURER: The Treasurer shall collect payment of dues, propose on an annual basis a budget for adoption by the body and make disbursements in accordance with the annual budget. The Treasurer shall also execute the duties essential to the disburse from discand to the maintenance of accurate and up to date fiscal records. The Treasurer shall report in writing the financial status of the organization to the President, general body, and Executive Board. The Treasurer shall also provide the general body ith an annual report at the end of fiscal year.
- 6. THE PARLIAMENTARIAN: The Parliamentarian shall serve as an active participant in all general meetings and those of the Executive Board.oHsche shall define all rules governing the process by which EXVLQHVV LV WR EH FRQGXFWHG 5REHUW¶V UXOHV RI 2U conducting its official business.
